 - EBT cards: Eligible once an individual qualifies for SNAP or cash benefits (Temporary Assistance); Allows one to buy groceries & other items with cash benefits at participating stores and locations <https://otda.ny.gov/workingfamilies/ebt/>
 - WAP: Weatherization Assistance Program (energy efficiency measures) <https://hcr.ny.gov/weatherization>
 - (HUD) Low income Household Water Assistance Program: helps pay cost of drinking water and wastewater services <https://otda.ny.gov/programs/water-assistance/>
